diverse as pachinko train stations chopsticks food physiognomy poetry and gift wrapping he muses elegantly on and with affection for a system altogether detached from our own for barthes the sign here does not signify and so offers liberation from the west's endless creation of meaning tokyo like all major cities has a center the imperial palace but in this case it is empty both forbidden and indifferent inhabited by an emperor whom no one ever sees this emptiness of the sign is pursued throughout the book and offers a stimulating alternative line of thought about the ways in which cultures are structured
