Backflow Prevention Certification Workshop Information and Materials 2016 the forum on microbial threats previously named the forum on emerging infections was created in 1996 in response to a request from the centers for disease control and prevention cdc and the national institutes of health nih the goal of the forum is to provide structured opportunities for representatives from academia industry professional and interest groups and government to examine and discuss scientific and policy issues that are of shared interest and that are specifically related to research and prevention detection and management of emerging infectious diseases in accomplishing this task the forum provides the opportunity to foster the exchange of information and ideas identify areas in need of greater attention clarify policy issues by enhancing knowledge and identifying points of agreement and inform decision makers about science and policy issues the forum seeks to illuminate issues rather than resolve them directly hence it does not provide advice or recommendations on any specific policy initiative pending before any agency or organization its strengths are the diversity of its membership and the contributions of individual members expressed throughout the activities of the forum recent increased attention to both united states and international public health systems as well as the medical research and treatment infrastructure has revealed significant deficiencies in their capacity to respond to infectious diseases medical and public health professionals may be poorly equipped to detect diagnose and treat common infectious diseases as well as those diseases that pose an unexpected threat the need for the development of domestic and international training programs in the expanding field of emerging and reemerging infectious diseases is well recognized well trained infectious disease professionals form the basis of a strong national healthcare system the forum on emerging infections now renamed the forum on microbial threats convened a 2 day workshop discussion the subject of this summary to examine the education and training needs to ensure an adequate infectious diseases workforce the workshop reviewed trends in research training programs and discussed the requirements for establishing successful educational initiatives and training programs to ensure a competent and prepared workforce for current and future challenges in infectious diseases some key disciplines explored as case study examinations included infectious disease epidemiology vaccinology vector biology and public health laboratorians

Ensuring an Infectious Disease Workforce 2006-02-15 fao in collaboration with the global ghost gear initiative gggi convened a series of regional workshops on best practices to prevent and reduce abandoned lost and otherwise discarded fishing gear aldfg between may and november 2019 the workshops which involved government representatives regional bodies relevant intergovernmental and non governmental organizations the fishing industry and other regional stakeholders covered the southwest pacific southeast asia west africa and south america and the caribbean regions workshop participants reviewed existing measures for addressing fishing related marine debris in particular aldfg considered best available information that supports further development of best practices for the management of fishing gear discussed provisions required within international instruments and identify region specific challenges opportunities and priority needs the main objective was to increase understanding and

awareness of the voluntary guidelines for the marking of fishing gear vgmfg and relevant best practice as outlined in the gggis best practice framework for the management of fishing gear bpf the main output of the workshops were a set of recommendations to inform next steps to be taken towards the development of national action plans or strategies to align as appropriate policies legislation systems and operations to the provisions of the vgmfg and the bpf which will support the implementation of regional action plans to address marine litter from sea based activities especially aldfg

Building Community, Helping Each Other 1995 in today's world the public faces many health threats from bioterrorism to the epidemic of obesity it's thus important to have an effective public health system this system depends significantly on the quality and preparedness of our public health workforce as well as the quality of public health education and training in march 2001 the robert wood johnson foundation asked the institute of medicine iom to examine the education of public health professionals and develop recommendations for how public health education training and research could be strengthened to meet the needs of future public health professionals to improve population level health as a result the committee on educating public health professionals for the 21st century was formed members can be seen in appendix a over the course of one year the committee held five meetings reviewed and analyzed key literature and abstracted analyzed and synthesized data from catalogs web sites and survey responses of accredited schools of public health because numerous institutions and agencies play important roles in public health education training research and leadership development the report addresses its recommendations to schools of public health degree granting programs in public health medical schools schools of nursing other professional schools e.g. law and local state and federal public health agencies conclusions and recommendations for each of these sectors are present in the report the report generated a lot of discussion resulting in the robert wood johnson foundation asking the iom to hold a workshop of interested people to foster joint discussion among the academic and practice communities the workshop was held may 22 2003 and over 100 representatives attended who will keep the public healthy workshop summary includes the workshop presentations recommendations workshop agendas and more

Creative Approaches to Pollution Prevention Training 1993 provides for the first time a comparative overview of practices from a to z it maps out practices to enhance integrity throughout the whole procurement cycle from needs assessment to contract management it also takes a global stance by including practices from non oecd countries

Pollution Prevention Training Opportunities in 1990 1990 describes the rationale and evidence for the effectiveness of various youth suicide prevention strategies identifies model programs that incorporate these different strategies for use by persons who are interested in developing or augmenting suicide prevention programs in their own communities

limited notwithstanding the services and contributions of the crime prevention and criminal justice branch as the united nations celebrates its fiftieth anniversary it is fitting to have a book that describes the united nations crime prevention and criminal justice programme the information it contains highlights the significant contributions of a number of organizations whose work may not be sufficiently known outside the circles of scholars experts and professionals in the field of international criminal justice the book is thus also a deserving tribute to these organizations giving greater publicity to what they have contributed over the years with scant united nations recognition without these organizations and the active ngos the united nations would hardly have leave to claim part of what is now an important though still insufficient contribution to international criminal justice
