in april of 2004 the long downward spiraling of amy bingaman s mental illness could no longer be hidden or ignored much less written off as a side product of a colorful and quirky character with no family able to help and no resources she was involuntarily locked up in the draconian archaic labyrinth that is the wyoming mental health system armed with only a pocket dictionary and any paper she could find to write on amy wrote not only as a journal but at times as her only coping mechanism to salvage what was left of a breaking mind in a love hate relationship with her alter ego who she d come to call lucille over the course of her first 33 days she kept copious notes of her time there detailing treatment or mistreatment befitting a prisoner rather than the sufferer of a psychological disorder these diaries roller coaster between terrifying and hilarious chronicling from her first morning waking up confused in a disheveled ball gown living at the mercy of staff who range from inept to cruel and with fellow patients who s light hope and brilliance are twisted with the daily wrestling of their own debilitating psychotic breaks from reality what results is an unedited in the moment take down of what consists of mental health care in this country as lived from the inside by its weakest links those it is intended to protect and for all the dark humor and vivid humanity she hopes you will be left with the knowledge that since that time little or nothing in the system has changed doug stanhope

when the boston globe first published clea simon's cover story on growing up with her two schizophrenic siblings the response was overwhelming healthy siblings constitute that silent

in 1887 nellie bly stormed into the office of the new york world one of the leading newspapers in the country she expressed interest in writing a story on the immigrant experience in the united states although the editor declined her story he challenged bly to investigate one of new york s most notorious mental hospitals bly not only accepted the challenge she decided to feign mental illness to gain admission and expose how patients were treated with this courageous and bold act bly cemented her legacy as one of the foremost female journalists in history nellie bly was born elizabeth jane cochran on may 5 1864 her family owned a lucrative mill in cochran pennsylvania at the age of six bly lost her father unable to maintain the land or their house the family moved her mother also remarried but later divorced due to abuse while attending indiana teacher s college elizabeth added an e to her last name becoming elizabeth jane cochrane due to the family s financial crisis she was unable to finish her education no longer in school bly focused on helping her mother run a boardinghouse one day an upset bly decided to pen an open letter to the editor of the pittsburgh dispatch her short but important piece pointed out the paper s negative representation of women the editor not only read bly s response he printed her rebuttal and offered bly a job as columnist as a newspaper writer she took the pen name nellie bly although bly was a popular columnist she was often asked to write pieces that only addressed women wanting to write pieces that addressed both men and women bly began looking for a paper that would allow her to write more serious work in 1886 she moved to new york city as a woman bly found it extremely hard for her to find work after pretending to be mentally ill for 10 days the new york world published bly s articles about her time in the insane asylum on blackwell s island in a six part series ten days in a mad house quickly made bly one of the most famous journalists in the united states furthermore her hands on approach to stories developed into a practice now called investigative journalism bly s successful career reached new heights when she decided to travel around the world after reading the popular book around the world in 80 days her trip only took 72 days which was a world record bly would only hold it for a few months in 1895 bly married millionaire robert seamen and retired from journalism bly s husband died in 1903 leaving her in control of a massive manufacturing company in business her curiosity and independent spirit flourished bly went on to patent several inventions related to oil manufacturing many of which are still used today in her later years bly returned to journalism covering the woman suffrage movement and world war i while still working as a writer bly died from pneumonia on january 27 1922 womenshistory.org
