## ***The Night-side of Nature; Or, Ghosts and Ghost-seers* 1850**

contains woolf s second and third novels night and day and jacob s room

## **The Great Gatsby 1993**

this book has long been celebrated as one of shakespeare s popular comedies it describes the central relationship between benedick and beatrice which is combative until love prevails

## **Night and Day 2012**

abandoned at birth and threatened with a life in service defoe s young rebel sets her heart on independence one fatal seduction and five husbands later she resorts to a life of self supporting crime

## ***Much Ado about Nothing* 1995**

includes stories such as the diamond as big as the ritz the cut glass bowl may day the rich boy crazy sunday an alcoholic case the lees of happiness the lost decade and babylon revisited

## **Tender is the Night 1993**

encompasses witchcraft bloody murder and ghostly apparitions this work tells the tragedy of a good brave and honourable man turned into the personification of evil by the workings of unreasonable ambition

## **Moll Flanders 1993**

three men in a boat three friends along with the dog montmorency experience the hazards and vicissitudes of life in a boating expedition along the thames

## ***The Diamond as Big as the Ritz 1994***

this is one of the earliest novels of industrial alienation tellingly linked to the plight of 19th century women it tells of the relationship between margaret hale a girl from the old rural south and john thornton a mill owner from the new industrial north

## ***Macbeth 1992***

includes tales which mostly appeared in the dublin university magazine and other periodicals

## **Three Men in a Boat 1993**

based on the fable of a man who traded his soul for superhuman powers and knowledge this text became the life work of germany s greatest poet goethe it is the dramatic poem that charts the life of a deeply flawed individual and his fight against despair and the nihilism of the mephistopheles

## ***North and South 1994***

generally regarded as the pre eminent work of conrad s shorter fiction heart of darkness is a chilling tale of horror which as the author intended is capable of many interpretations

## **Madam Crawl's Ghost 1994**

the arabian nights or one thousand and one nights is a collection of stories compiled by various authors translators and scholars from countries across the middle east and south asia the tales trace their roots back to ancient arabia and yemen ancient indian literature and persian literature ancient egyptian literature and mesopotamian mythology ancient syria and asia minor and medieval arabic folk stories from the caliphate era though the oldest arabic manuscript dates from the fourteenth century scholarship generally dates the collection s genesis to somewhere between ad 800 900

## ***Faust 1999***

story of tess durbeyfield the daughter of a poor and dissipated villager

## ***Heart of Darkness and Other Stories 1995***

the destructive effects of jealousy underlie this tale othello a man of quality and superior intelligence is brought down by his suspicions of his wife desdemona

## ***The Arabian Nights 2017-04-07***

there are six major characters in this novel their voices describe the intensity of childhood the optimism and physical awareness of youth the detachment of middle age sensations emotions perceptions come and go in the procession of the narrative like seasons like waves

## **Tess of the D'Urbervilles 1992**

the forsyte saga comprises of the man of property in chancery and to let produced in a single volume

**Othello 1992**

rat mole badger and the preposterous mr toad have brought delight to many through the years with their odd adventures on and by the river and at the imposing residence of toad hall

**The Waves 2000**

these accomplished tales from the pens of great writers are object lessons in the art of creating a literary masterpiece on a small canvas

**The Forsyte Saga 2002**

of all the writers of ghost and horror stories ambrose bierce is perhaps the most colourful he was a dark cynical and pessimistic soul who had a grim vision of fate and the unfairness of life which he channelled into his fiction

**The Wind in the Willows 1993**

a classic tale of the young englishman who gives up his life during the french revolution to save the husband of the woman he loves

**The Wordsworth Collection of Classic Short Stories 2007**

vampires those dark children of the night who rise from their coffins to suck the blood of the living continue to hold a strange fascination and dread this book presents vampire stories some familiar some less so

**Terror by Night 2006**

a young englishman branded as a coward seeks personal redemption for an act of selfishness

**A Tale of Two Cities 1993**

from homer and shakespeare to toni morrison and jonathan safran foer major works of literature have a great deal to teach us about two of life s most significant stages growing up and growing old distinguished scholar arnold weinstein s provocative and engaging new book morning noon and night explores classic writing s insights into coming of age and surrendering to time and considers the impact of these revelations upon our lives with wisdom humor and moving personal observations weinstein leads us to look deep inside ourselves and these great books to see how we can use art as both mirror and guide he offers incisive readings of seminal novels about childhood huck finn s empathy for the runaway slave jim illuminates a child s moral education catherine and heathcliff s struggle with obsessive passion in wuthering heights is hauntingly familiar to many young lovers dickens s pip in great expectations must grapple with a world that wishes him harm and in marjane satrapi s autobiographical persepolis little marjane faces a different kind of struggle growing into adolescence as her country moves through the pain of the iranian revolution in turn great writers also ponder the lessons learned in life s twilight years both king lear and willy loman suffer as their patriarchal authority collapses and death creeps up brecht s mother courage displays the inspiring indomitability of an aging woman who has borne every possible blow but is still standing still moving and older love can sometimes be funny rip van winkle conveniently sleeps right through his marriage and sometimes tragic as j m coetzee s david lurie learns the hard way in disgrace tapping into the hearts and minds of memorable characters from sophocles oedipus to artie in art spiegelman s maus morning noon and night makes an eloquent and powerful case

for the role of great literature as a knowing window into our lives and times its intelligence passion and genuine appreciation for the written word remind us just how crucial books are to the business of being human

## **Children of the Night 2007**

set in 1859 at the moment when the russian autocratic state began to move hesitantly towards social and political reform this novel explores the conflict between the liberal minded fathers of russian reformist sympathies and their free thinking intellectual sons whose revolutionary ideology threatened the stability of the state

## **Lord Jim 1993**

presents an apocalyptic fantasy of the end of human civilisation set in the late twenty first century this novel unfolds a sombre and pessimistic vision of mankind confronting inevitable destruction interwoven with a futuristic theme it incorporates portraits of shelley and byron yet rejects romanticism and its faith in art and nature

## **Morning, Noon, and Night 2011-02-15**

the story of one of the most brilliant flamboyant and historically important men who ever lived a superb achievement literary review combines scholarship with storytelling to bring the ancient world to life in his masterly new caesar he shows us the greatest roman as man statesman soldier and lover simon sebag montefiore magnificent daily telegraph from the very beginning caesar s story makes dazzling reading in his late teens he narrowly avoided execution for opposing the military dictator Sulla he was decorated for valour in battle captured and held to ransom by pirates and almost bankrupted himself by staging games for the masses as a politician he quickly gained a reputation as a dangerously ambitious maverick by his early 30s he had risen to the position of consul and was already beginning to dominate the senate his affairs with noblewomen were both frequent and scandalous his greatest skill outside the bedroom was as a military commander in a string of spectacular victories he conquered all of gaul invaded germany and twice landed in britain an achievement which in 55bc was greeted with a public euphoria comparable to that generated by the moon landing in 1969 in just thirty years he had risen from a position of virtual obscurity to become one of the richest men in the world with the power single handedly to overthrow the republic by his death he was effectively emperor of most of the known world

## **Fathers and Sons 1995-10-23**

a collection of stories featuring detectives criminal agents and debonair crooks from the golden age of crime fiction a time when sherlock holmes was esconced in his rooms at 221b baker street and london was permanently wreathed in a sinister fog
