the optimal control of flexible structures is an active area of research the main body of work in this area is concerned with the control of time dependent displacements and stresses and assumes linear elastic conditions namely linear elastic material behavior and small deformation see

eg 13 the collections of papers 4 5 and references therein on the other hand in the present paper we consider the static optimal control of a structure made of a nonlinear elastic material and undergoing large deformation an important application is the suppression of static or quasi-static elastic deformation in flexible space structures such as parts of satellites by the use of control loads 6 solar radiation and radiation from other sources induce a temperature field in the structure which in turn generates an elastic displacement field the displacements must usually satisfy certain limitations dictated by the allowed working conditions of various orientation sensitive instruments and antennas in the space vehicle for example a parabolic reflector may cease to be effective when undergoing large deflection the elastic deformation can be reduced by use of control loads which may be implemented via mechanically based actuators or more modern piezoelectric devices when the structure under consideration is made of a rubber like material and is undergoing large deformation nonlinear material and geometric effects must be taken into account in the analysis

it is now more than twenty years since a proposal was first mooted to hold an international tunnelling symposium in Britain at the time of the first

symposium held in london in 1976 the channel tunnel project had just been shelved last weekend a charity walk was held in the finished tunnel which will be open for business later in the year tunnels have figured prominently and at times spectacularly in the development of national and international links and it is hoped that such links gather pace in the future it is particularly pleasing that alastair biggart of storebrett has agreed to deliver the twenty sixth sir julius wernher memorial lecture of the institution of mining and metallurgy entitled the changing face of tunnelling at the start of this event although almost every edition of the technical journals on tunnelling reports another 1 billion scheme somewhere in the world it would be unfair of me to suggest that tunnelling is restricted to these prestigious schemes for major transport links much of the work that makes modern life possible receives hardly a mention outside the technical press and one suspects that society at large applies the out of sight out of mind attitude even more readily to underground construction than it does to other forms of engineering clearly there is a continuing need to improve the capacity and performance of our infrastructure while having a careful regard for the environment

the heaviest of the known elements is curium which was recently discovered by seaborg and his associates this new element can be produced by the alpha particle transmutation of plutonium by the following

reaction ${}^{239}\text{Pu} \xrightarrow{\alpha} {}^{235}\text{U} + {}^4\text{He}$ this isotope of curium is radioactive and decays by the emission of an alpha particle to form plutonium 238 which in turn is also radioactive curium 242 has a half life of 150 days and its radioactive daughter plutonium 238 has a half life of 50 years this isotope of plutonium decays by the emission of an alpha particle to form uranium 234 which has a half life of 233 000 years shortly after the organization of the atomic energy project it became apparent that formidable problems would be presented as the result of the release of nuclear energy one of the most urgent of these was the hazard presented by the production of large quantities of the radio elements created by the fission of uranium and the coincidental formation of neptunium and plutonium in an attempt to evaluate the potential danger presented by these radio elements from the chain reacting pile a large series of metabolic studies with experimental animals were undertaken in a number of laboratories working upon the atomic energy program these studies which have been briefly summarized elsewhere included a series of investigations on the metabolism in the rat of the more important members of the fission products in the carrier free state as well as most of the heaviest elements at the end of the periodic table these studies made it possible to predict on a semi quantitative basis the potential hazards that this large number of radioactive elements might present should they gain entry into the body

in recent years the field of contact dermatitis has increased greatly in importance in dermatology the variety of exogenous environmental ly caused dermatoses has undoubtedly expanded over the past few de cades with the increasing number of potentially toxic chemicals the changes in lifestyle and the greater life expectancy in industrialized societies the value of international cooperation in this field has long been realized and acted upon by the international contact dermatitis re search group icdrg by 1975 the international journal contact dermatitis had been founded under the editorship of c d calnan thanks largely to the icdrg and contact dermatitis there were by 1986 enough additional dermatologists and scientists with a special interest in this area to form the european environmental and contact dermatitis research group eecdrg within 2 years they had in stituted the european society of contact dermatitis escd as an in ternational forum for researchers in the field the eecdrg decided

to hold a symposium in heidelberg in may 1988 an initiative supported by the icdrg and on this occasion the new escd held its inaugural session the society already has over 200 members and most national contact dermatitis research groups in europe are already represented new members are of course welcome subgroups and working committees have been formed to address various topics including the standardization of patch testing photodermatology and bioengineering

first published in 2003 gabriele d'annunzio was born in 1863 in pescara on the adriatic coast of italy the son of a wealthy landowner his first volume of poetry was published in 1879 when he was sixteen after graduating from the university of rome d'annunzio married and began to write short stories to support his wife and family in 1919 d'annunzio led a small force to seize the town of fiume ruling it as a dictator until 1921 d'annunzio spent the later part of his life at his home on lake garda in 1937 he was made president of the italian royal academy he died in 1938 and was given a state funeral by mussolini when halcyon was first published

at the end of 1903 its author was already forty and famous j placere which ranks with a rebours and the picture of dorian gray as a novel of the decadence had appeared in 1889 and d annunzio had published other novels short stories plays and many volumes of poetry since his first great success at the age of sixteen
